Notes to Gift Aid Declaration

- 1 You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- 2 You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- 3 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains tax equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
- 4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
